- 6. Treat others with respect.
- 7. Cheer others on.
- 8. Share the ball and take turns.
- 9. Have fun.
- 10. Win or lose, be a good sport.

A *Safe Sports Space is a space where all athletes, coaches, physical education students and teachers, and spectators and families are safe and treated with respect, regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity/expression.

*Gym, pool, track, playing field, locker room, weight room, training room, coaches' or teachers' offices, or any other sports space in a school.
